To Whom It May Concern:

As you may know, ESSE Canada was retained in 2021 by Chippewas of Georgina Island First Nation to provide support services in the completion of their Septic Inspection Program.

Please find enclosed the results of the Chippewas of Georgina Island First Nation Septic Inspection Program. This brief summary report provides information regarding the wastewater treatment system (WTS), or greywater system (GS), located on the subject property.

The program's findings have been classified into three categories:

- Category 1:
No overt malfunctions identified; system is in substantial compliance with section 8.9 of the Ontario Building Code
- Category 2:
Repairs and upgrades recommended to reduce vulnerability to system component failure
- Category 3:
Significant component malfunctions identified, system must be repaired or replaced to come into compliance with section 8.9 of the Ontario Building Code

As prescribed by the Chippewas of Georgina Island First Nation, in the event the WTS or GS fall into categories 2 or 3, repairs, upgrades or other work may be required to bring the property's system into compliance. A timeline of one (1) calendar year has been established to complete the prescribed work and/or provide documentation with proof of an agreement to have the work done.

The leadership and management at Chippewas of Georgina Island First Nation will provide further information and details regarding the support, completion and inspection of prescribed work, as well as guidance regarding qualified professionals for work completion.
