

GIFN Outdoor Fire Safety





Respect the flame—stay safe!

- **Adhering to Fire Bans**
- ✓ Check the fire danger rating regularly
- If a fire ban is in place, do not light any outdoor fires.
- Choosing a Safe Location
- Ensure it is not windy
- ✓ Use a designated fire pit with flame retardant edging.
- ✓ Keep fires at least **one metre away** from flammable material such as grass or wood piles.
- **☑** Ensure there are **three metres of clearance** from any structure.
- Building & Maintaining Your Fire
- Keep fires small (max one metre high and wide).
- ✓ Never leave a fire unattended.
- Have water and a shovel nearby for control.
- Extinguishing Properly
- Do not leave until your fire has been fully extinguished.
- Pour lots of water on the fire.
- Stir the ashes and add more water until cold to the touch.
- Ensure no smoke or hissing remains.

In case of a fire emergency occurring, including a forest fire

- call 911
- tell them there is a fire emergency and location
- make sure you have been connected to the York Region dispatch centre
